Admission to these masterclasses will be based on your application accompanied by an audio recording.

Audio links or audio hard copy must be submitted by July 1, 2021.

Please enclose the application form, audio (link or hard copy) and a recommendation letter from one professional.

Instruments : violin, viola, cello, piano.
Piano lessons will be focusing on piano accompaniment and chamber music.

Minimum audio recording requirements for Violin, Viola and Cello:

a) 2 contrasting movements of J. S. Bach's Solo Partitas or Sonatas for Solo Violin

OR

J. S. Bach's Suites for Solo Cello

b) A movement of a major concerto

Pianists are free to send the repertoire of their choice.

### **Fees**

Lessons are free; accommodation and meals: CHF 600.-The candidates are responsible for arranging travel at their own cost.
