

Admission to the Rencontres Musicales will be based on your application with a video. Please enclose the application form, the video, a CV with a photo and a reference from a professional.

The video link and the registration form must be sent at the latest one month before the Rencontres Musicales

Instruments: violon, viola, cello.

I) <u>Candidates are selected on the basis of their applications:</u>

Minimum video requirement are as follows:

- a) 2 contrast movements of Bach solo, partitas or sonatas
 - **OR** J.S. Bach's Suites for Solo Cello
- b) One Movement of a major concerto

II) For the final audition during the Rencontres, select 3 pieces, one classical, one romantic, and one by Bach.

The pieces submitted via video can be played for the final selection

Fees for the week

Lessons are free. For accommodation and meals: CHF 600. The candidates are responsible for their own travel.

Fondation Simon I. Patiño - Académie Menuhin

The International Musical Encounters were created in 1984 by the Simon I. Patiño Foundation and organized in collaboration with the Menuhin Academy with the aim of bringing together young musicians of the highest level through courses, concerts and workshops specially focused on chamber music.

During these meetings, future students of the Menuhin Academy are selected and recruited for a period of 3 years, during which courses, accommodation and meals are offered to the students.

Lord Menuhin's wish was to offer young string virtuosos from all over the world the opportunity to perfect their abilities by taking lessons with the best professors and by performing in many public concerts given by the **Menuhin Academy** chamber orchestra.
